This is just some last minute basic information for YEMS.

YEMS is being held at Marlboro High School in Marlboro, NY on February 11. *The snow date is March 24 @ Miller School.* Busses can drop off right in front of the High school in our bus lane. Teachers and parents should have plenty of parking in front or on either side of the high school. There is also additional parking in the back of the high school.

Directions to Marlboro High School 50 Cross Road, Marlboro, New York 12542

From the south: Take 9W north to Marlboro. 8 miles from Newburgh, (Same distance from Mid-Hudson Bridge) make a left at Key Bank onto Western Avenue through village. Bear left to Plattekill Road. High School is on the left.

From the North: 9W South, 8 miles from from Mid-Hudson Bridge. Make a left at Key Bank onto Western Avenue through village. Bear left to Plattekill Road. High School is on the left.
